PROCESS	CRITERIA/PRIORITIES
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students currently attending schools on an approved transfer do not need to reapply. 2. For Kindergarten and new students in 1st – 5th grades, both the registration process <i>and</i> an Application for Schools of Distinction must be completed and submitted to the attendance area school by Friday, February 10, 2012. 3. Fill out one application per child. 4. Indicate your choices of schools in the order of preference beginning with 1 as first choice, 2 as second choice, etc. Applicants are not required to make more than one choice. 5. Select only those schools you wish your student to attend. Every effort will be made to assign students to their first preference; however, students may be assigned to any one of their choices. 6. All applications must be received by Friday, February 10, 2012. 7. Applicants will receive a confirmation form when the Application for Schools of Distinction has been received. 8. The District will conduct a lottery using established procedures. 9. Notification of the status of your application will be mailed March 09, 2012. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students who wish to stay in their attendance area schools do not need to apply. 2. Sibling preference will be given to applicants who have a brother or sister currently attending the school to which they are applying. 3. Students who live within a .5 mile radius of a magnet school will be given preference. 4. Students not selected will be placed in a waiting pool and called to fill vacancies as they occur. 5. Late applications will be accepted; however, late applicants will be placed in a late application pool. 6. The waiting pool will be maintained until the end of October. 7. It should be noted that the District reserves the authority to maintain appropriate diversity. Final decisions will be made on space availability at each school site and the need to maintain diversity and equitable class sizes throughout the District.

Parents are invited to attend Information Night presentations to learn more about each School of Distinction. These presentations will be held during the week of January 17 and at different times to allow families to learn about the educational experiences offered at each campus.
