

What is the difference between the API and the AYP?

Academic Performance Index (API)

- State
- Growth – measures change in academic achievement for students from one year to the next

Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP)

- Federal
- Performance – measures the % of students at/above the proficient level

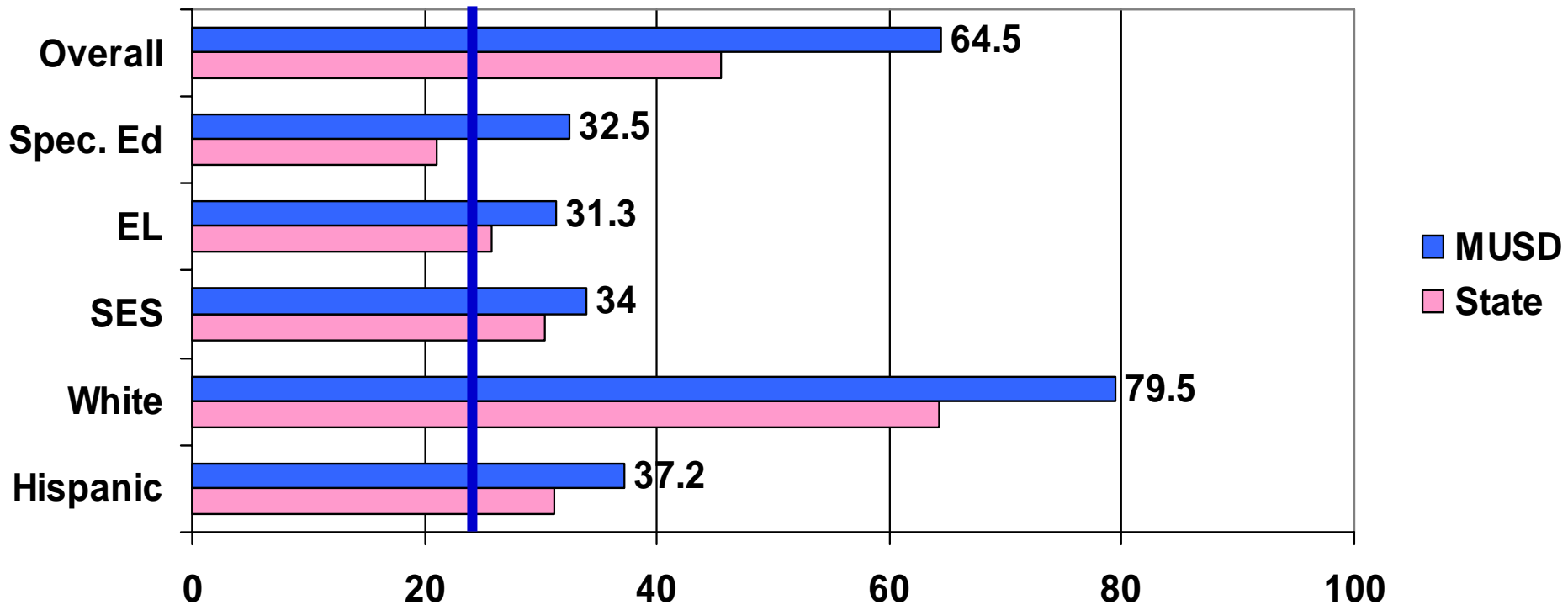

AYP: How did we do in English-language arts?

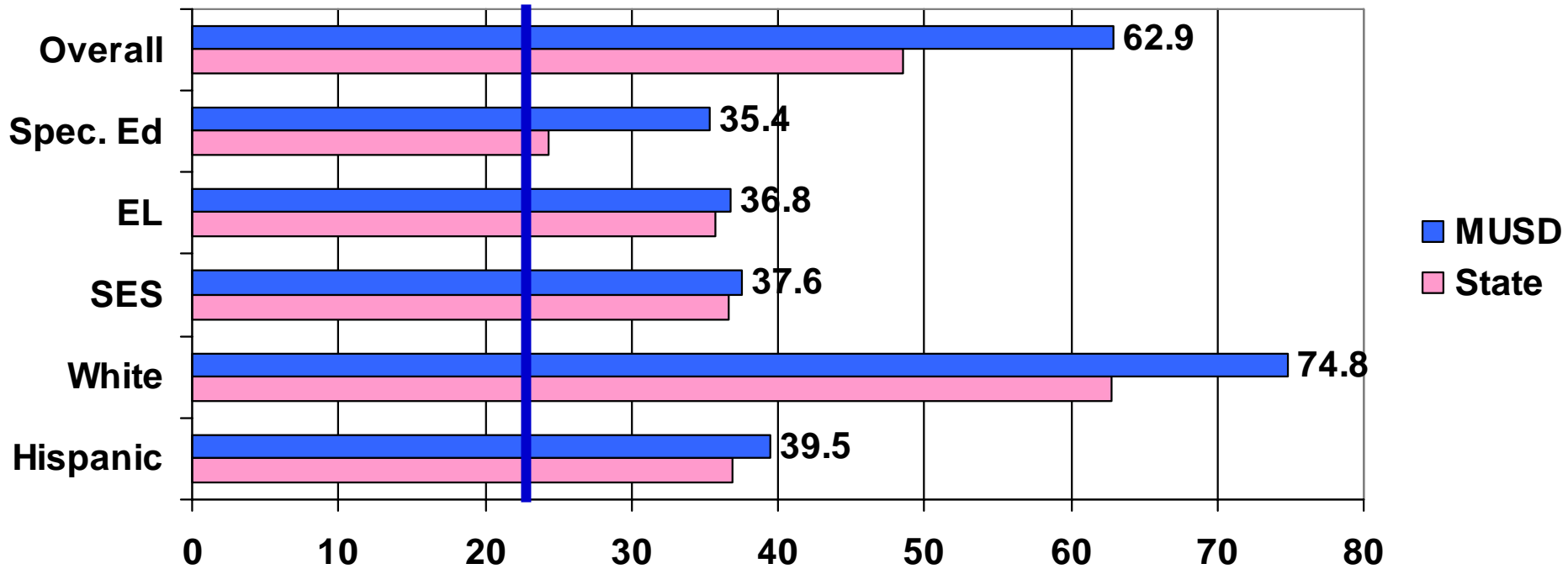
English-Language Arts – Percent At or Above Proficient
